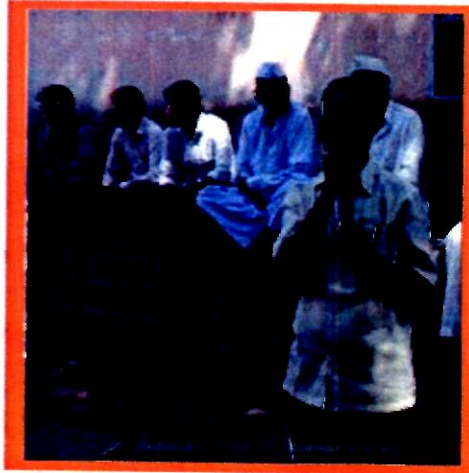

Village Khanapur:

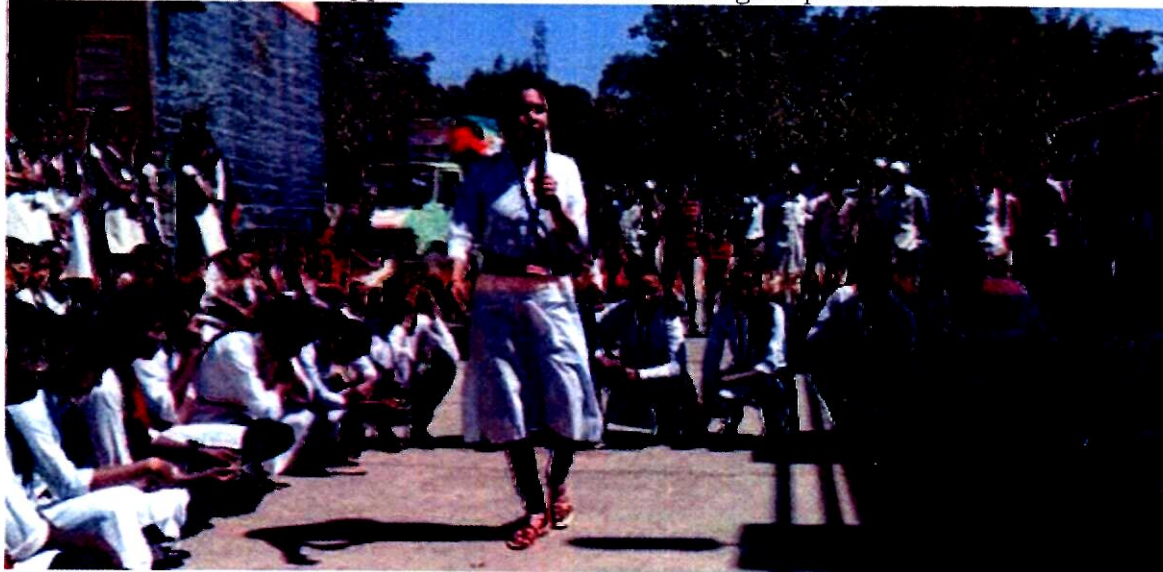

Village: Anadur



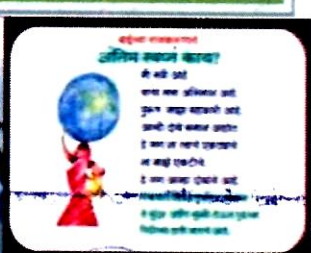

Village: Khudawadi

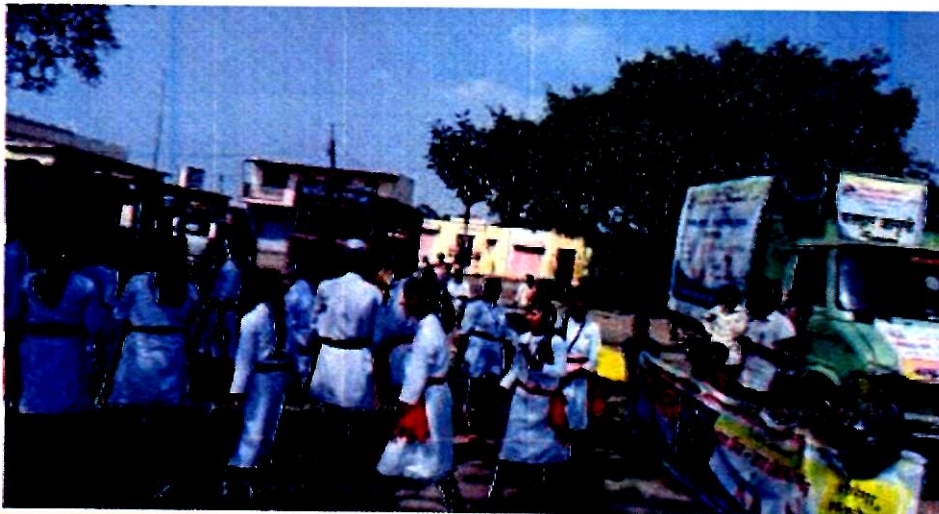



Awareness on EVM, VVPAT

An awareness programme on **Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) and Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT)** organized by Hon. **Soudagar Tandale, Tahasildar, Tuljapur** was held at **Jawahar Arts, Science & Commerce College, Anadur, Taluka-Tuljapur, Dist- Osmanabad on October 9, 2019.**

This awareness programme highlighted various aspects of EVM and VVPAT functions. Master Trainer from Z. P. School teachers Mr. Vijaykumar Sadafule, Mr. Guruling Dhawane, Mr. Vijaykumar Bhalekar, Mr. Vishal Suryawanshi, Mr. Vikas Chavhan, Mr. Anil Ghuge, Mr. Bhairavnath Kanade and Mr. Shivaji Vedpathak demonstrated on how the EVM and VVPAT worked to the young and eligible voters who have applied for enrollment in the Electoral Roll. This team of Teachers created awareness among the voters with songs and recreation games for the students and staff.



In view of the fourth coming general election to **Maharashtra State Legislative Assembly-2019** and awareness program on familiarization of **Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) and Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT)** was held on **9th October 2019** for the **Jawahar College students and staff.**

Explaining the detailed functioning of the EVM, the trained teachers informed that EVM is designed with two units:

- 1) The control unit and
- 2) The balloting unit.

These units are joined together by a cable. The control unit of the EVM is kept with the Presiding Officer or the Polling Officer. The ballot unit along with VVPAT is kept within the voting compartment for the electors to cast their votes. With the EVM, instead of issuing a ballot paper, the polling officer will press the ballot button which enables the voter to cast their vote. A list of candidates' names, photos and symbols will be available on the machine with a Blue button next to it. The voters can press the

button next to the candidates' name they wish to vote for, he added. Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) or Verifiable Paper Record (VPR) is a method of providing and independent verification system for voting machines designed to allow voters to verify that their vote was cast correctly and to provide a means to audit the stored electronic results.



It contains the serial number, name of the candidate (for whom vote has been cast) and symbol of the party /individual candidate. Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) machines are used during the election process to verify that the vote polled by a voter goes to the candidate they voted for.

VVPATs are a second line of verification and are particularly useful in the time when allegations around Electronic Voting Machines tempering crop up.

After a voter presses the button on the EVM against the chosen candidate, the VVPAT prints a slip containing the name of the candidate and election symbol and drop it automatically into a selected box. The machines give the chance for the voters to verify their vote. The machine is placed in a glass case in a way that only the voter can see it.



The slip is displayed to the voter for 7 seconds after which the VVPAT machine cuts it and drop it into the paper compartment with a beep. Five (5) Polling stations are randomly selected for physical counting of VVPATs slip. If any discrepancy arises at the time of counting, VVPATs slips will be mandatorily counted for that particular polling station.

It may be mentioned that EVM demonstration centers are set up in the offices of the Tahasildar and the District Magistrate in all district headquarters and all the officers of the Returning Officers (ROs) in compliance with the instructions of the Election Commission of India. It is mainly set up to make the voters/ citizens have the live experience on the EVM /VVPAT and sensitize them about the operations of the EVM.

More than 300 students and staff attended this awareness programme.

The Taluka Election Officer Hon. Soudagar Tandale conducted comprehensive EVM and VVPAT familiarization and awareness programme for Tuljapur Assembly Constituency.

The master trainer of Z. P. School teachers for EVM and VVPAT has given the demonstration in depth to all the students and staff.
