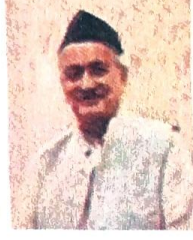

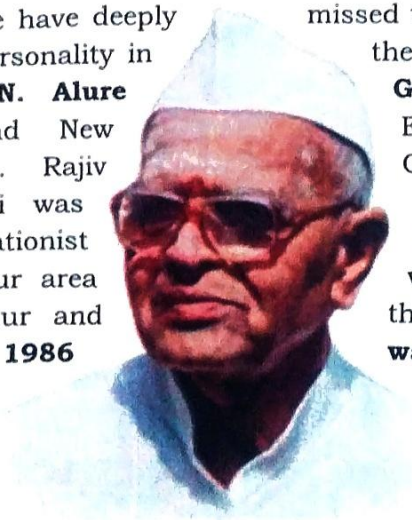
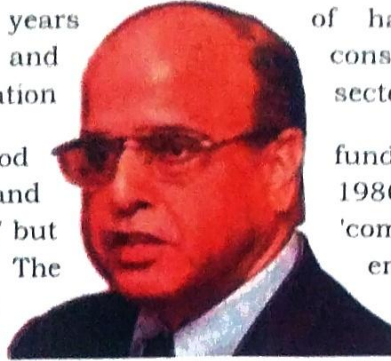
Preface: Need of Seminar

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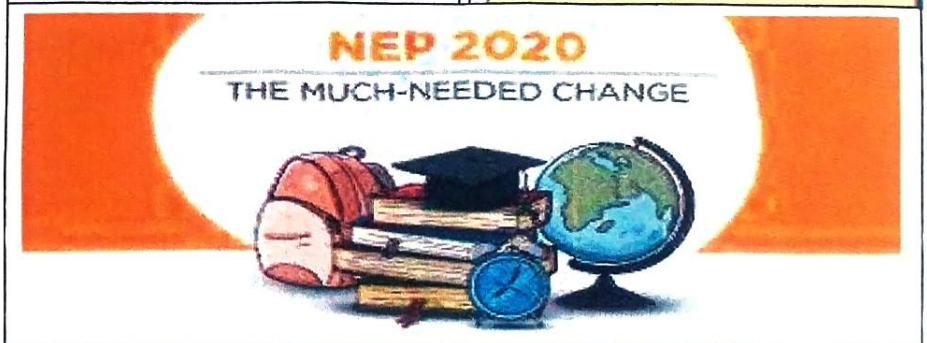
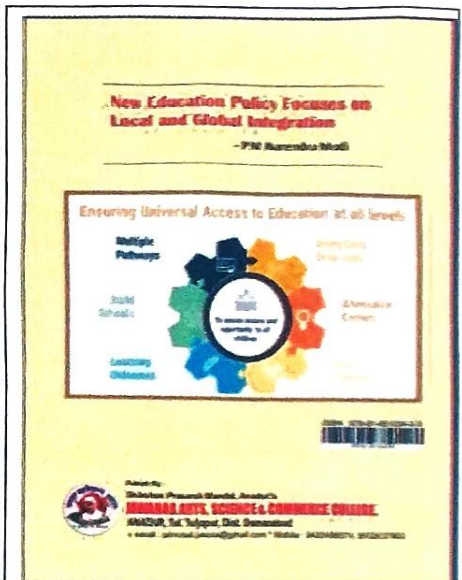
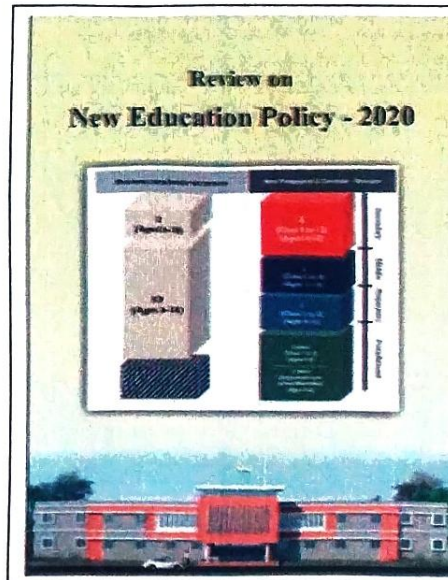

College Principal Dr. Umakant Chanshetti in his introductory speech he explained that, in the context of the new education policy and also the CBCS grade point which will be implemented from the coming academic year, Jawahar College has

organized this national seminar today so that we should discuss this and let the professors know about it. On behalf of the Jawahar family, I welcome all the professors, teachers, education lovers and students from various colleges who participated in this seminar.

As you know today 21st May is the memorial day of former Prime Minister of our country Late Rajiv Gandhi, who worked to bring Science and Technology to rural areas and dreamed of connecting every village with internet. In 1986, Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi introduced second education policy, which continues till today. After 34 years with slight changes in this, on behalf of the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development Chairman of NEP K. Kasthurirangan has brought this new education policy. The earlier diagram was 10+2+3. Now it has been changed to 5 + 3 + 3 + 4 and in this the students have got an opportunity to take two or three subjects at the same time and also he can choose subjects from different branches in this educational policy. But a question arises that, if he or she is eager to study from two different Universities at the same time, how will he/she arrange his attendance? How to complete his academic session? If these and many such questions come to our mind as a teacher, then this seminar has been organized to discuss all these questions and understand them.

This policy plans to provide skill oriented education. India is an agrarian country with 80% rural areas, when we factor in skills. The major occupation in the villages is agriculture, so if skill oriented education can be imparted, it should be complementary to agriculture. As Mahatma Gandhi said, in the year 1937 in 'Nai-Talim' that if both vocational and education are given to the students at the same time, then they can lead a self-reliant life. So today, the responsibility of facilitating skill oriented education is on the professors keeping in mind the rural students. Realizing the need in our locality, if we can provide education in agriculture based industries along with this gradual course, it will definitely raise the standard of living of students in rural areas.

Speaking after the inauguration, **Vice-Chancellor Dr. Mrunalini Fadnavis said that,** Hello everyone dear all present for the seminar, First of all I would like to thank Jawahar College for inviting me here and giving me the opportunity to talk about the new education policy. Until we understand exactly what is in this new policy, how will it be implemented? This question comes in everyone's mind.

I appreciate all the Board of Directors and all colleagues of this Jawahar College, because they dared to organize such seminar in offline mode after Corona and that too in a rural area.

This seminar is an opportunity for you. So we all are teachers, we know the future of students; we try to provide where it falls short. This policy is student centric, we should first read and understand its draft, so that it can be properly implemented and students will be aware of how to make a better future. Implementation of this new educational policy is a big responsibility on us; let us briefly understand what to take in this responsibility just as changes are happening in the society, they are also happening in the education sector. It is necessary to understand the many problems facing the country today and find the right answers for them. Our citizens are going to do this work, but they need proper education for it. The questions of today's twenty-first century are also new and the method of finding their answers is new. This necessitates a different approach to education.

That is why the work of new education policy started. We have a lot of information in the syllabus and expect to remember it, but it doesn't make it possible to get the answer to the problem at hand. So the question of why this education is useful is always there, so this new educational policy is designed with the aim of imparting education that creates hope in students to think for them or to find answers to



questions, to take the society to a different height, instead of just providing information.

At this time, she expressed the opinion that this policy can give a new direction to the country.

Speaking further, she said that in one sentence, this policy is about providing stress-free creative education. Till now we were becoming administratively competent in the field of education. Educationally it was changing to some extent. But that was not enough. This is why it has become necessary to bring about changes in pre-primary to higher education. Until now, the education policy was made in the country 34 years ago in the year 1986. In the last 34 years, various aspects of education have changed. New knowledge generation, new methods of learning to acquire it, research proven knowledge about how the human brain is capable of many things have made it necessary to look at education from a different perspective. The main objective of this new education policy is to provide very good quality education to all.



She also gave detailed guidance to all the participating teachers regarding Academic Credit Bank. The aim of the ABC, Regulations is to enable students to “choose their

own learning path to attain a Degree or Diploma or Post Graduate diploma or academic qualification, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exit ("MEE") as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level learning". To supplement these Regulations, the UGC has also released guidelines on the implementation of Multiple Entry& Exit in Academic Programs offered in HEIs.

In the presidential conclusion, **Hon. Ramchandra Dada Alure said that,** Today's seminar was inaugurated by Hon. Dr. Mrinalini and Fadnavis all respected platform and brothers and sisters present, this seminar is very challenging. Our discussion should be expressed through speaking and writing. We can show your suggestions to the government which will facilitate the implementation of this policy. We think that the purpose of this seminar should be to wake them up by telling us in advance what the errors in it are.



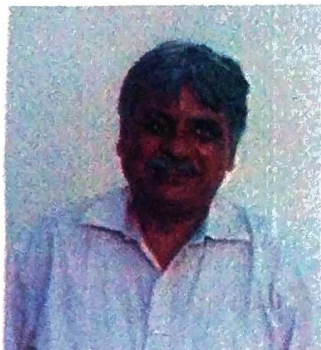

Key Note Address

Speaker: Prof. (Dr.) Vijay Joshi, Director, RUSA, Maharashtra, Mumbai

In this seminar Dr. Vijay Joshi while addressing all the participating professors through video conferencing said that,



the global standard of education is considered in terms of its dimensions and the Indian higher education that stands the test, the thing to be noticed is that we have a dearth of world class educational institutions i.e. colleges and universities. Why did this happen to our higher education? Looking into this, it can be seen that though our higher education has developed in the 73 years of independence, it has remained isolated and has not become employment oriented.

The graduates we have produced have not been skilled manpower. As a result, higher education does not seem to contribute much beyond creating an army of unemployed. The main task of higher education is to create new knowledge, for that education needs to be innovative. Research is the soul of higher education. Today the professors of every college need to recognize the skills of their students and pay attention to how they will stand the test of usefulness in the field of competition in this world and in this new educational policy it is seen that Mahatma Gandhi's concept of providing vocational skill and education at the same time has been implemented. Through this educational seminar, we were all urged to brainstorm on how to make students in rural areas more quality and competent.



Speaker: Dr. Makarand Paithankar, Principal, S. B. College, Aurangabad

Topic: NEP 2020 and Higher Education



Dr. Makarand Paithankar while giving detailed guidance by throwing light on the new education policy said that, through this NEP, our country's education system and research facility will become more robust and with the help of this, students who spent thousands of dollars on education in foreign countries will get global standards in line in India.

He explained in depth about, **Higher Education under NEP-2020**

- Higher education plays an important role in improving human well-being and developing India and through this NEP they aim to increase their **GER from 26.3% to 50% by 2035**, and around 3.5 cr new seats will also be added to higher education institutions.
- Under this, UG education could be of 3 or 4 years with numbers of entry and exit options.
- Multidisciplinary education and Research University will be set up of global standards.
- HECI (Higher education commission of India) will be the only body for entire higher education (except medical and legal education)
- HECI will have 4 independent verticals such as **NHERC (National higher education regulatory council)** for a directive, GEC (General education council) for standard setting, HEGC (Higher education grants council) for sponsoring, and NAC (National accreditation council) for reorganization.
- Globalization of higher education.
- An academic bank of credit will be established in which credit earned by the students during their academics from different HEIs could be stored and transferred at the time final degree.
- National research foundation will act as a peak body that fosters a strong research culture and builds research capacity covering higher education.

College Affiliation under NEP 2020

The affiliation of colleges will be phased out in 15 years and a mechanism will be established for granting graded autonomy to colleges. And after some time it is presumed that every college will develop into a self-governing degree provider or an intermediary of a university.

Dr. Makarand Paithankar, focused on student's choice based learning system in which there is **No hard separation of streams under NEP 2022.**

Every student will get the opportunity to engage in arts and humanities as well as in the study of arts and science and social science because of this no hard separation going to be done between **'curricular' and 'extra-curricular activities' or 'co-curricular activities'**

- Every school subject will be considered as curricular rather than extra or co-curricular which includes yoga, sports, dance, music, sculpting, woodworking, gardening, and electric work.
- NCERT will prepare syllabi and textbooks as per the **NCF (national curriculum framework)** so that these subjects could be incorporated into the curriculum which **SCERTs (State councils of educational research training)** in states may edit, rewrite, and supplement as per their needs.
- Physical education will be incorporated strongly throughout their curriculum with a consideration that what is interesting and safe at each age.
- Also, there is no hard separation between 'vocational' and 'academic' stream because they wanted every student will get an equal opportunity to develop both capabilities.

While speaking about evaluation system, he explains about PARAKH

To improve the education system in the state under the National Education Policy a committee has been formed under the chairmanship of Former Pro-VC of Mumbai University Dr. Ravindra Kulkarni, he informed that the higher and technical education department has taken a decision and issued instructions to start the implementation of the four-year degree course plan along with the three-year degree course from the next academic year.

Topic: Curriculum Structure according to CBCS pattern



All dignitaries present on the occasion of today's seminar on **National Education Policy**. I congratulate and appreciate Jawahar College for organizing this conference on a brand new topic and the institute for providing all the facilities to the college. Congratulations to Principal of this college Dr. Umakant Chanshetti and Prof. Dr. Ankush Kadam and everyone for organizing this seminar successfully.

First of all, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to appear before you. As such, this topic is very important. Now there is technology. There has been a lot of discussion on this through internet, WhatsApp and other social media. Awareness about the CBCS pattern is being created but when it comes to practicality, the participation of all should be essential. When implementing something new, awareness about it is very important and it is certainly commendable that this Jawahar College has done this. Even in the context of Ph.D. guidance, Jawahar Colleges was conducting such online workshops to educate everyone. Vice-Chancellor of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad Hon. Prof. Dr. Pramod Yeole was supposed to come to this place today, but he has to go to Parbhani today due to the additional charge of Parbhani Agricultural University. So I have brought his message to this place today, so he entrusted me with the task of greeting this conference.

The CBCS pattern will be implemented from the next academic year and now we are going to talk about this process in this seminar today in order to make all the elements of the education sector know about it including teachers, students, and administrators. Earlier also Jawahar College had organized a webinar in the context of Ph.D. process online during the Covid period. At that time around 250 to 300 faculty participated and understood this process and I appreciate that this is the first workshop within the jurisdiction of the University, which is going on in this Jawahar College to understand this CBCS pattern.

During the seminar Dr. Bhalchandra Waykar highlighted on the main components of CBCS Pattern.

The University Grants Commission (UGC), one of the statutory organizations, is a key player in maintaining the quality of education across Indian Institutions. Right from evaluating teaching-learning practices to bringing innovations in the field of education, UGC introduces various schemes from time to time for quality assurance. Continuing with the trend of fast-paced educational reforms, the University Grants Commission ("UGC") recently notified the (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education), Regulations, 2021. The Regulations inter alia provide for the establishment of an Academic Bank of Credits ("ABC") which will facilitate the recognition and transfer of credits earned by students, amongst various Higher Education Institutions ("HEI").



The aim of the ABC, Regulations is to enable students to "choose their own learning path to attain a Degree or Diploma or Post Graduate diploma or academic qualification, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exit ("MEE") as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level learning". To supplement these Regulations, the UGC has also released guidelines on the implementation of Multiple Entry & Exit in Academic Programs offered in HEIs.

The Regulations and Guidelines are revolutionary in the context of how higher education in India has conventionally operated. The Regulations introduce learning flexibility and a system of earning and redeeming credits which, albeit prevalent in several other countries, evaded India.

1. **What is the Academic Bank of Credits?**

The ABC will be a national-level online facility established by the UGC with the approval of the Central Government. Its aim will be to promote flexibility of curriculum framework and interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary academic mobility of students across HEIs in India. It will be established on the lines of the "**National Academic Depository**" ("**NAD**") which stores a student's academic documents, and will have a website providing all details of the ABC scheme and its operational mechanism for the

use of all stakeholders of higher education. It is proposed to function similar to a commercial bank with students as account-holders. The ABC will provide services such as credit accumulation, credit transfer, and credit redemption through the opening, closure and validation of academic bank accounts (“ABA”).

Students who pursue education as freelancers can also accumulate credits which can be deposited to student accounts. Upon collection of a degree, diploma or certificate, these credits will be debited / deleted from the bank account. This will help a student to avail Multiple Entry & Exit options in HEIs, based on preference, convenience or necessity, and opt for a tailor-made degree and flexi-learning models.

The ABC will act as the body empowered by the Central Government/UGC to provide authenticated records of credits earned by students from registered HEIs. Nevertheless, the Regulations clarify that the ABC will not encroach upon the statutory powers of HEIs to award degrees and other academic qualifications.

The primary objectives of the ABC and MEE system are *inter alia* to:

1. Promote student centricity with learner-friendly approach in higher education;
2. Promote a more inter-disciplinary approach;
3. Enable students to select the best courses to suit their aptitude and quest for knowledge;
4. Permit students to choose a pace and associated logistics and costs for their studies;
5. Allow students to tailor their degrees or make specific specializations;
6. Enable MEE for students to complete their degrees as per their time preferences, providing mobility across various disciplines and HEIs for degree, diploma or certificate program or course work for the Ph.D. program;
7. Facilitate lifelong learning amongst all, including informal students; help students acquire the right foundations and building blocks to pursue their life goals;
8. Curtail dropouts and improve Gross Enrolment Ratio.

How Does the Academic Bank of Credits Work?

1. The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) would act as a reference point for faculty to check the credit records of students. The students need to follow the given guidelines to be a part of the ABC.

2. Opening the ABC Account

a. First and foremost, the students need to open an "Academic Bank Account".
b. They might require details like their **name, address, certificates, course details**, etc. to create the ABC account. A unique ID & password will be created from where students can log in at any given point to check their earned credits.

3. Credits Information as Per Courses

As per the courses, a credit structure will be created by the Government. When a student pursues any course and clears exams, credits will be automatically awarded to them. Institutions need to fill out the details and upload the deposits in the students' Academic Credit Bank's account on the digital portal.

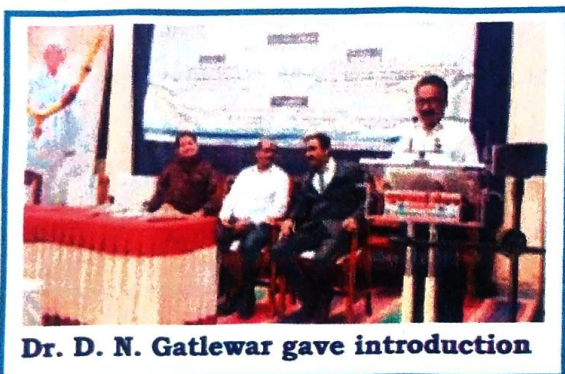
4. Evaluation & Verification of Credits

a. Any kind of credit evaluation & verification will be carried out by the Academic Credit Bank at regular intervals. If students want to transfer the credits, they need to approach the ABC for further process. It will help in regulating the processes with ultimate authenticity.

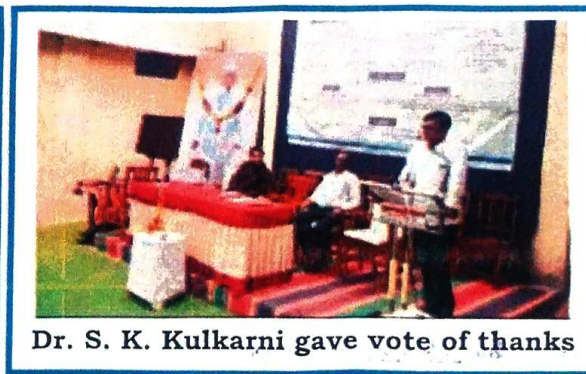
b. ABC shall not be, by itself degree awarding organization, the statutory degree awarding power shall continue to be vested with the eligible, HEI which have registered with ABC

c. ABC shall act as the empowered body by UGC/ to provide authenticated record of credits earn by students and from approved HEIs. Credit requirement as well as essential components of study for award of any UG/PG degree or diploma etc. would be defined by respective university/institute participating in the ABC.

During his conclusion he said that, the Regulations and Guidelines are new, but revolutionary in nature. It will be important for the UGC to popularize the concept of credit transfers. The UGC has already called upon HEIs to implement the ABC scheme at the earliest, so that students can benefit from this commendable move by the UGC. While some HEIs have already registered for this scheme, it will also be important for more HEIs to register themselves so that students can actually take benefit for it. A concerted approach of HEIs for transfers, and award of credits may also be helpful for students seeking transfers or pursuing different courses from the ones offered by the registered HEIs. All in all, the ABC scheme is a highly facilitative and enabling- both HEIs and students can explore hitherto unexplored options and combinations of subjects which would lead to a truly holistic learning experience.

On this occasion, while expressing his opinion about this new education policy, Dr. H. N. Jagtap said, while deciding a new educational policy, the committee has kept in mind some important things. It has some responsibility for education. Education should create a very knowledge based and work cultured society. At the same time, this education should be affordable and all the components of the community should get quality education. Education should create a commitment of fundamental rights in the society as well as the commitment of values in the Constitution. Not only that, he should be a responsible citizen of the country but also a responsible citizen of the world, so that it will continue to be striving for sustainable development.

In this policy the committee has imbibed on the facts as, the respect towards the society, the involvement of various components of the community, the participation of

the community, technology used in education, as only the government does not have the responsibility of education.

Education is not expected to create only a stereo type production. Considering the features of various languages, provinces, culture in the society, and they want to develop students by giving them. It is expected to pay more attention towards the development of the curriculum with not only the information but it should develop the efficiency of the students. The curriculum should develop the research culture among them.

Further Dr. H. N. Jagtap informed that, teachers themselves have to spend 50 clock hours per year on their own development, which includes various trainings, seminars, project preparation and implementation. The medium of education up to class VIII will be mother tongue or local language and there will be no Arts, Science & Commerce branches at this level. From 9th to 12th, students have to study a total of 40 subjects in various sessions. Board exam will be held in 12th instead of 10th. As at present, this examination will be conducted twice a year. But in this exam, instead of importance of subjective questions, there will be questions to test the ability of the students. So obviously junior college or higher secondary school will not be the type.

On the occasion of this seminar, the book "**Review on New Education Policy -2020**" edited by Prof. Dr. Meena Jadhav and her colleagues were released by dignitaries .

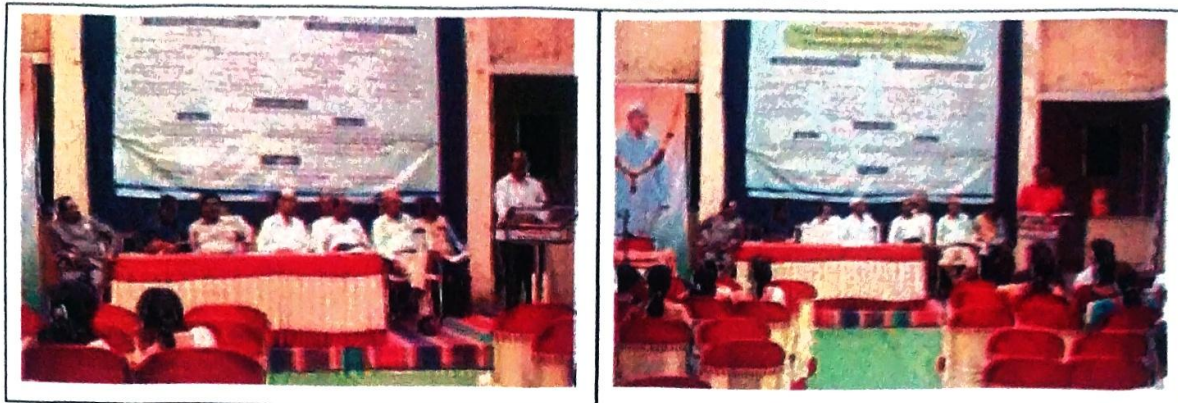


During the presidential conclusion **Hon. V. G. Suryawanshi Guruji** said that, in the earlier curriculum, there were subjects like work experience and basic industry,

Prof. Dr. Rajshekhar Nalge was introduced the chief guest of the concluding program Principal Dr. H. N. Jagtap.

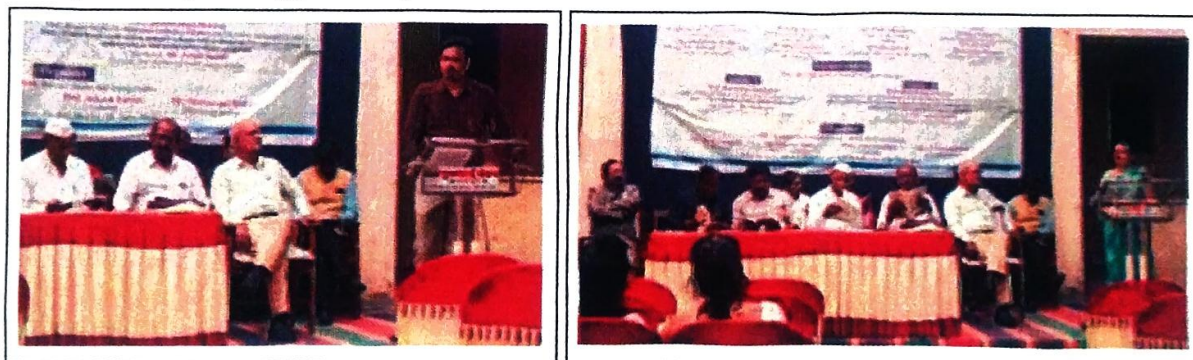
Vice Principal Dr. Mallinath Langade, expressed gratitude to all participant Professors, Teachers and Students, who actively participated in this National Seminar.

They also expressed their gratitude to the Jawahar College, Anadur and the organizers for providing this opportunity.

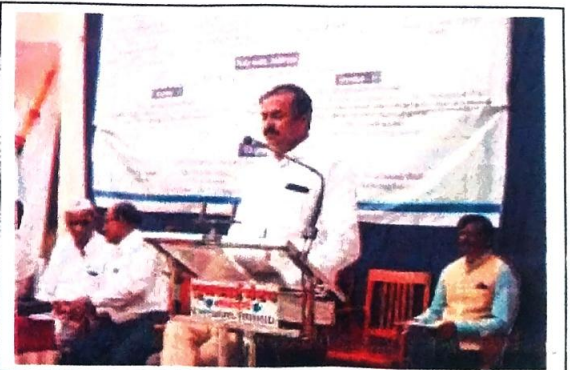

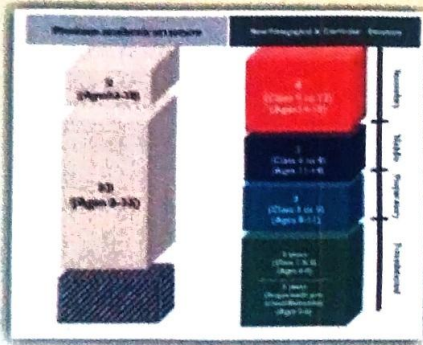

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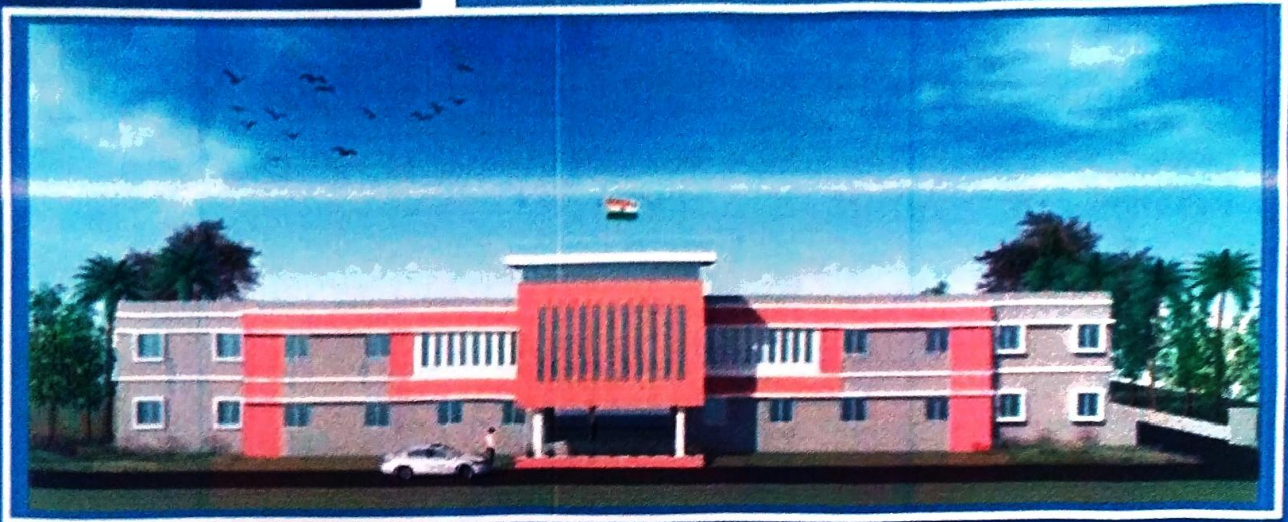
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
