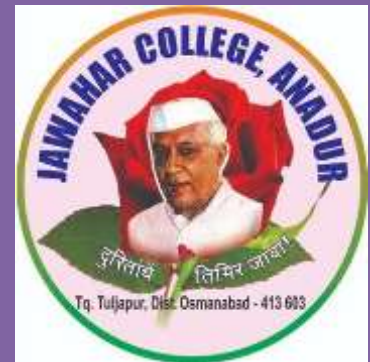

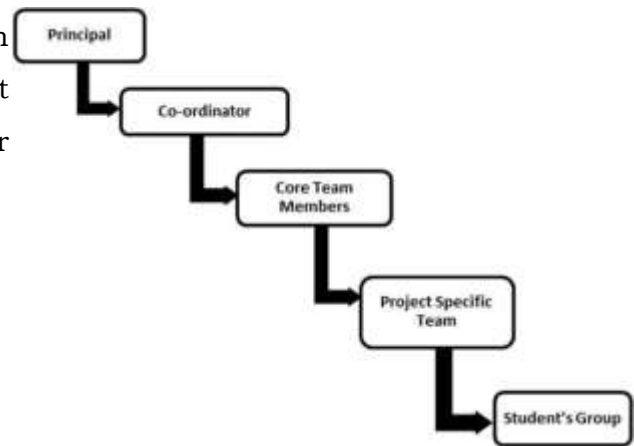

Extension Activities In the Academic Year: 2017-18



As in the academic year 2016-17, this year 2017-2018 also the National Service Scheme Department in our college received approval from the university for 200 volunteers for regular program and 100 volunteers for annual special camp. Various extension activities related to educational, cultural and social activities have been organized on behalf of National Service Scheme, Nature Club, Science Association and Jawahar Social Responsibility Cell. During the year all these activities were implemented in our college in the academic year 2017 - 2018 under the supervision of the Programme Officers and Coordinators of the respective Cell.

1. International Yoga Day: June 21, 2017

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June 2017 in the premises of Jawahar College. This Yoga Day was celebrated communally on behalf of Jawahar College, Jawahar Secondary and Higher Secondary School and Art of Living, Andur.

On this occasion, the founder Secretary of the organization Shikshanmaharshi Hon. S. N. Alure Guruji, Treasurer Hon. G. K. Biche Guruji along with Principal Dr. Meena Jadhav, Principal Prof. Sangmeshwar Jalkote along with teachers, professors, non-teaching staff, prominent citizens of the village, villagers and students were participated. In this Yoga Day, Yoga teacher Mr. Laxman Nare, Prof. Dr. Mallinath Birajdar and Prof. Suryakant Aaglave taught Pranayama and Yoga through demonstration. After this, Principal Dr. Meena Jadhav guided the students by explaining the importance of this day.



2. Van Mahotsav: July 1- 7, 2017: Initiatives of Tree Plantation

A tree plantation program was conducted in Jawahar College from July 1, 2017 to July 7, 2017 under Van Mahotsav. During this period, the students prepared for the plantation by digging pits for planting trees, putting black soil and manure in them. Secretary of the Institute Shikshanmaharshi Hon. S. N. Alure Guruji, Principal Dr. Meena Jadhav, faculty and students planted trees during this period. For this, saplings were received from Gram Panchayat. Professors helped these trees by providing tree guards. Professors and students took responsibility for planting trees and preserving them. The students provided water to the trees through pipelines.



3. Cleanliness fortnight: August 1- 15, 2017: Initiatives for Cleanliness

Cleanliness fortnight was observed in the college from 1st August to 15th August 2017. On 2nd August 2017, Oath of cleanliness was administered to all the students and faculty. After that, the college premises, laboratories, classrooms, roof of the college were cleaned. Through this initiative, everyone was asked to try to maintain the cleanliness of their home and surroundings along with personal hygiene. Efforts were made to inculcate cleanliness among the students through this campaign.



4. Awareness for Eye Donation: Sep 8, 2017: Initiatives for Organ Donation

Awareness for Eye Donation is to encourage people to donate their eyes after death while raising awareness about blindness and visual impairment. Eye donation involves donating your corneas, and almost everyone can do so, saving the sight of patients for many years.

Eye Donation Fortnight is celebrated annually by the Department of Health during 25th August to 8th September. On this occasion, on September 8, 2017 in Jawahar College, to create awareness among the students regarding eye donation, ophthalmologist of Osmanabad Health Departments, Dr. C. S. Mahindrakar's lecture was organized by the English Department of the College.

On this occasion NSS program officer Prof. Suryakant Aglave, Head of English Department Prof. Dr. Anita Mudkanna and Prof. Vivekananda Wahule along with Professors and students of the college were present.

Speaking on this occasion Dr. Mahindrakar said that, if a person donates eyes after death, two blind people can get sight at the same time. Then he appealed to the audience to participate in this eye donation movement and resolve to bring light into the lives of the blind.



5. National Service Scheme Day: September 24, 2017.

National Service Scheme Day was celebrated in the college on 24th September 2017. A lecture program was organized on the occasion of National Service Scheme Day on 25 September 2017. On this occasion Prof. Laxman Birajdar from Adarsh College, Omurga guided the students on the topic "**NSS and Student's Participation**" and explained the benefits and importance of NSS. While speaking, Prof. Birajdar said that, NSS is a platform where students can prove their leadership and competence. 11. Cleanliness at Village Jalkot: January 17-23, 2018

Since the purpose of this annual special camp was, “**Youth for Village Cleanliness and Village Survey**”, during this period the entire village was inspected and cleaning work was planned.

In this mainly the work of cleaning of public areas was distributed to the students.

- In front of the gate of Zilla Parishad School, the damaged road was repaired and the road was made better for transportation.



- The area around the school was cleaned and some students saw the cooking arrangement.

- Cleaned the drains by removing the sludge from the drains



- Atrophy pits were taken in places where there was no sewage system
- Sanitation and cleaning of public spaces

12. Village Survey:

The students were given forms to conduct the village survey and the wards of the village were divided among them and sent home to home to conduct the survey. Students should interact with families during this survey; know their difficulties; create bonds with that family so that social awareness and sensitive attitude can be cultivated among the students. This was the motto behind this.



During this survey, the students collect the details of that family, their occupation, their agriculture, the information about the crops in the field, whether there are any business or occupations besides agriculture, whether cleanliness is taken care of in the house, whether there is a toilet in the house, what is the system for drinking water, pets in the house, vehicles. And the students worked to collect information about the physical tools and facilities in the house. At the same time, the student informed the family members how to take care of cleanliness and health, how to purify drinking water.



13. Plantation:

Tree plantation can help them survive and live peacefully. It is thus important for maintaining biodiversity in the environment. Biodiversity is extremely essential for maintaining the ecological balance in the environment.

In the main square of Jalkot village, around the statue of Shivaji Maharaj, pits were taken for planting trees and filled with black soil and manure. The students planted trees along with Hon. Ramchandra Dada Alure, Deputy Sarpanch and prominent citizens of the village. A tree guard was fitted for the conservation of these trees.

Road safety teaches people how to conduct themselves while driving or crossing roads. Road safety measures are aimed at reducing the risks of people getting involved in accidents in the first place. Following these measures, the chances of accidents, injuries and damage to property are vastly reduced.



Jalkot is a village on the National Highway. This road is always crowded with vehicles. Moreover, the village is divided on both sides of the road. The students enlightened the citizens through street play on how to take care to avoid accidents while crossing the road.

Under Road Safety Campaign, students performed a street play on

the main road of Jalkot to prevent citizens from driving under the influence of alcohol, not using mobile phones while driving, not taking triple seats on motorcycles, how to help after an accident? Such safety message was given through street play.

5. Shivaji was known for engaging in both alliances and warfares with the Mughal rulers.
6. Shivaji's forces expanded the Maratha Empire, capturing and building great forts.
7. Shivaji was a pioneer in building a naval force and an extremely competent army.
8. When he was just 15, Shivaji persuaded Inayat Khan, the commander of Bijapuri to hand over the Torna Fort to him.
9. Shivaji's encounter with Afzal Khan is well documented in history.
10. Shivaji encouraged Marathi and Sanskrit instead of Persian in his court and administration.

The academic year 2020-2021 has gone under the spell of (Covid-19) Corona epidemic. Taking care to prevent the spread of Corona, some online and some offline extension activities were conducted in the college under the regular program of the National Service Scheme.

1. Food to Oldage Destitute & Daily wages Labors:

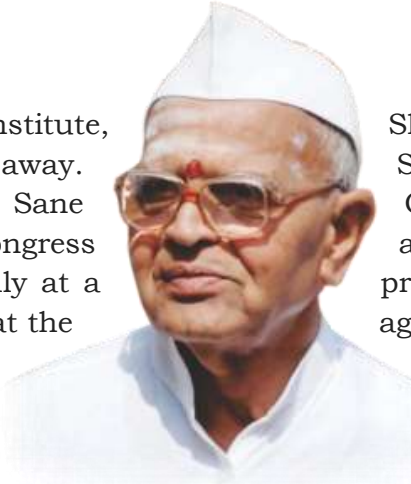

The consequences of child marriage are adverse for both males and females but much more significant for females. Girls are affected in much larger numbers and with greater intensity. Child marriage can be seen across the country but it is far higher in rural than in urban areas. Girls belonging to poorer families, scheduled castes and tribes, and with lower education levels are more likely to marry at younger ages. Girls are disproportionately affected as they are the majority of the victims.

To prevent such child marriages and create awareness among the society-

During the presidential conclusion, Principal Dr. Umakant Chanshetti said that, children of farmers and farm laborers study in our college. They are in dire need of this skill. Even if a few hours a day after the training are given for this bulb making work, it can bring financial benefits to the students. In the courtyard of Jawahar Vidyalay on Saturday 26th February 2022, on the occasion of Marathi Raj Bhasha Day i.e. on the birth anniversary of poet Kusumagraj, a public lecture of Arvind Joshi, a senior journalist from Solapur on the topic of “Marathi language Needs Classical Status,” was organized on behalf of Marathi Department of Jawahar College, Anadur.

The program was presided over by Sarpanch Hon. Ramchandra (Dada) Alure, while Principal Umakant Chanshetti, Principal Suresh Thombare, Head of Marathi Department, Prof. Dr. Sanjay Kulkarni Prof. Dr. Rajshekhar Nalge, former Deputy Sarpanch Sidram Nare and other dignitaries were present.

Further Arvind Joshi said that, Marathi language is spoken in the first fifteen languages in the world. There are 34 dialects of Marathi. His speech depends on food and water of that particular area. Therefore, Marathi has a special title in different areas. Marathi language has a history of 2500 years and it was spoken as Prakrit. He appealed to stop infiltration of English words in it and try to speak pure Marathi.

Till date six languages namely Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam and Odia have been given classical status. But it has not been given to Marathi yet. For classical status, the language should be ancient and its literature should be of high quality. He also expressed hope that it will be received soon. Marathi language has more literary forms than any other language. There are types like Bharud, Powada, Lavani. Marathi language is the best language. He urged everyone to read the literature of Sant Tukaram and Sant Dnyaneshwar.

Arvind Joshi presented in very simple language with his fluent voice.

15. Women's Day 2022: Online Lecture of Adv. Savita Shinde Single Women's Rehabilitation: Reality and Solutions



On behalf of the Late Shantakaki Alure Women Empowerment Center, NSS and Sociology Department of Jawahar Arts, Science & Commerce College, Anadur on the occasion of World Women's Day, on Tuesday 8th March 2022, an online lecture on the topic, "Single Women's Rehabilitation: Reality and Solutions" by eminent speaker Advocate Savita Shinde, Karmala, a social worker working in the field of single women rehabilitation. It was organized under the chairmanship

of Dr. Umakant Chanshetti.

Introduction of this program and introduction of guest speaker was done by Prof. Dr. Anita Mudkanna. Sarpanch and Chairman of Jawahar College Education Committee Hon. Ramchandra Dada Alure was the prominent presence.



Adv. Savita Shinde starts her speech with asking such questions-

How to survive as a village widow?

Widows in Maharashtra face serious questions today. Lack of education, no means of sustenance, and the family does not ask, then how does she live?

We have been working with widowed women in Corona for the last two years. Advocate Savita Shinde presented the reality before the audience while speaking about the problems and solution plans of single women in the society while giving a lecture through online. She highlighted on the following issues, which suffered by the widows,

1) The most important question today is the employment of these widows. These women are in dire need of employment due to the death of the bread earners in the house. Widowed women in the village do not have much education and do not get jobs, such women do not have the training or capital to start their own business. For them, it is necessary for governments to start loan schemes with no collateral and no interest.

2) Getting loan is the problem of widow women today. Government says go to self-help groups Women in urban areas are not in self-help groups. It is necessary to create a personal loan plan for such women.



3) The government had introduced the Pandita Ramabai interest refund scheme in the budget. But her mandate was not implemented. It needs to be removed immediately.

4) Urban widows are today suffering from debts. Husband bought a house, bought a car for business. But his loan did not fit. During the Corona period, women became debtors by taking medicine. Such women are threatened by banks and debt collectors.

5) Today in-laws are treating these widows very disrespectfully. Some women were even forced to leave their homes within ten days. A woman does not get her right. These women who have never left home are not likely to go to court for their rights. The fate of widows is to work as a laborer on their own farm or to leave the house to work elsewhere.

6) Earlier people of her maternal home used to give her strong support, brother would fight for her. Her village, her caste, her relatives, would help her. Today these widows are alone. These women lead a lonely life under the evil eye of men.

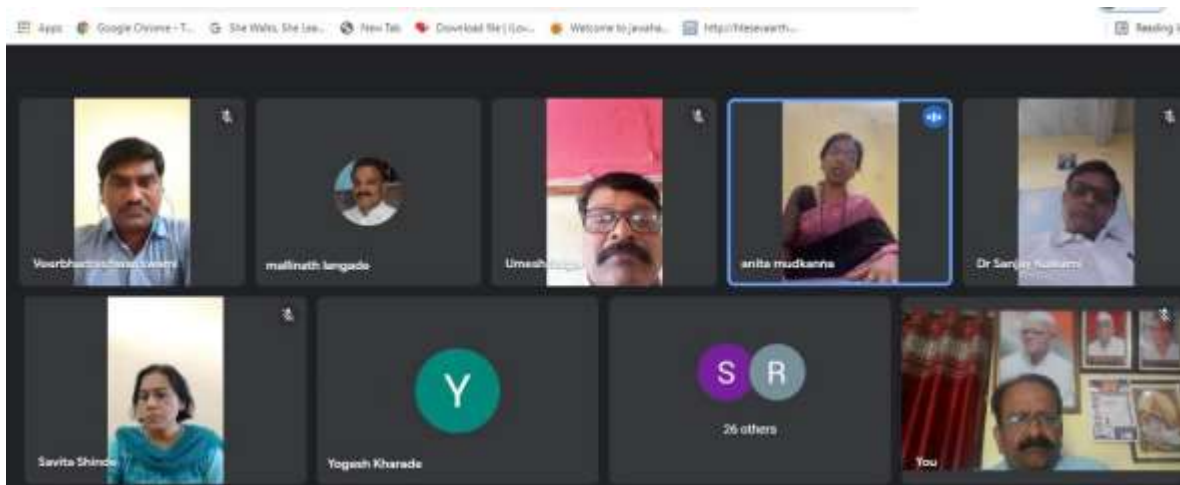
7) More than 70 thousand widows whose husband died due to corona virus in the state, 75 thousand widows are due to farmer suicide, widows due to death coz of alcohol, deaths due to road accidents, widows due to death with serious diseases, it add up to lakhs. Widows are believed to constitute ten percent of the total female population. At the same time, the number of divorcees and deserters has increased greatly in the society. Moreover, the rate of abandoning women without divorce is also high.

In such a situation, the number of single women is huge in Maharashtra. Advocate Savita Shinde asserted that the government needs to come up with a separate policy for all these single women.

Principal Dr. Umakant Chanshetti catching the point of Advocate Shinde's statement during the presidential conclusion he said that, Government needs to come up with a separate policy for single women. In this policy, when a woman becomes a widow, her heirs will be registered, widow pension will be given, child care scheme will be given to children, and employment opportunities will be provided by making them members of self-help groups. The government should pay attention to ensure that all these matters are implemented immediately and the government should make efforts to ensure that these works are done from a single office of women and child welfare. Also there is a need to encourage young single women to remarry. Remarriage is not accepted for women with children. In order to encourage adoption with children, if the government marries a single woman, the government should keep an amount in the form of fixed deposit in the name of the children of that woman and should also provide government benefits to the youth who remarries. In this way, if we accept a social responsibility and enlighten the society in this way, we think that this movement of reformers of Maharashtra will go ahead.

The lecture was concluded after vote of thanks by Prof. Virbhadra Swami of Department of Sociology.

All professors, students and citizens from all over Maharashtra participated online in this lecture.

to create awareness among the society, this day is celebrated on the first of December of every year. World AIDS Day was first declared in 1988. AIDS is a virus-caused disease. HIV, when it enters the human body, damages the individual's immunity system completely. AIDS cause severe infections and

health problems which if not taken medicine and proper treatment might kill the patient. AIDS is not curable, but its effects are controlled through medicines and treatments. Society very wrongly treated AIDS patients because of certain superstitions. The awareness spread by the campaigns of World AIDS Day is to guide people about AIDS using facts.

Principal Dr. Umakant Chanshetti threw light on, how this disease outbreaks and human being gets infected? & how is HIV transmitted?

He explained in-depth, People can get or transmit HIV only through specific activities, such as sex or injection drug use. HIV can be transmitted only in certain body fluids from a person who has HIV. These fluids are blood, semen, pre-seminal fluids, rectal fluids, vaginal fluids, and breast milk. To reduce your risk of HIV, you have to take precautions. Do not inject drugs. If you do, use only sterile injection equipment and water, and never share your equipment with others.



Further speaking Dr. Chanshetti said that, Several NGOs are working towards uplifting the conditions of AIDS patients and helping them. Around one million people die because of AIDS every year. So for that I humbly appealed you my young friends don't take any risk which causes such disease. Every youth was urged to live a carefree life keeping the ideal of Swami Vivekananda before marriage and Prabhu Ramachandra after marriage.
